Ezemplu: Fó sabraka **ida** mai ha'u! Se ema hakarak buat ruma spesífiku, sei uza artigu definidu – i.e. Fó sabraka **ida-ne'e** mai ha'u!

Iha lian inglés, iha artigu indefinidu 2: **a** no **an**. Sira-nia signifikadu hanesan de'it. Uza **a** ka **an** depende ba SON hosi liafuan ne'ebé tuir. Se liafuan ne'ebé tuir mak iha son konsoante nian, nune'e ita uza **a**. Se liafuan ne'ebé tuir mak iha son vogál nian, ita uza **an**. ENGLISH GRAMMAR **A - AN** **Mastering**

The difference between **A** and **AN**

A and **AN** have the same meaning. **A** and **AN** are indefinite articles. The difference depends on the sound at the beginning of the next word.

When the next word starts with a CONSONANT SOUND	When the next word starts with a VOWEL SOUND
A	AN
a book a frog	an apple an orange
a car a lemon	an egg an umbrella
a dog a truck	an insect an actor

BE CAREFUL! The **SOUND** of the letter is important

a house **BUT** **an** hour (The H at the beginning of **hour** is silent.)

an uncle **BUT** **a** university (The U at the beginning of **university** sounds like **YOU**.)

This rule applies to all words after **A** or **AN** (including adjectives, adverbs...)

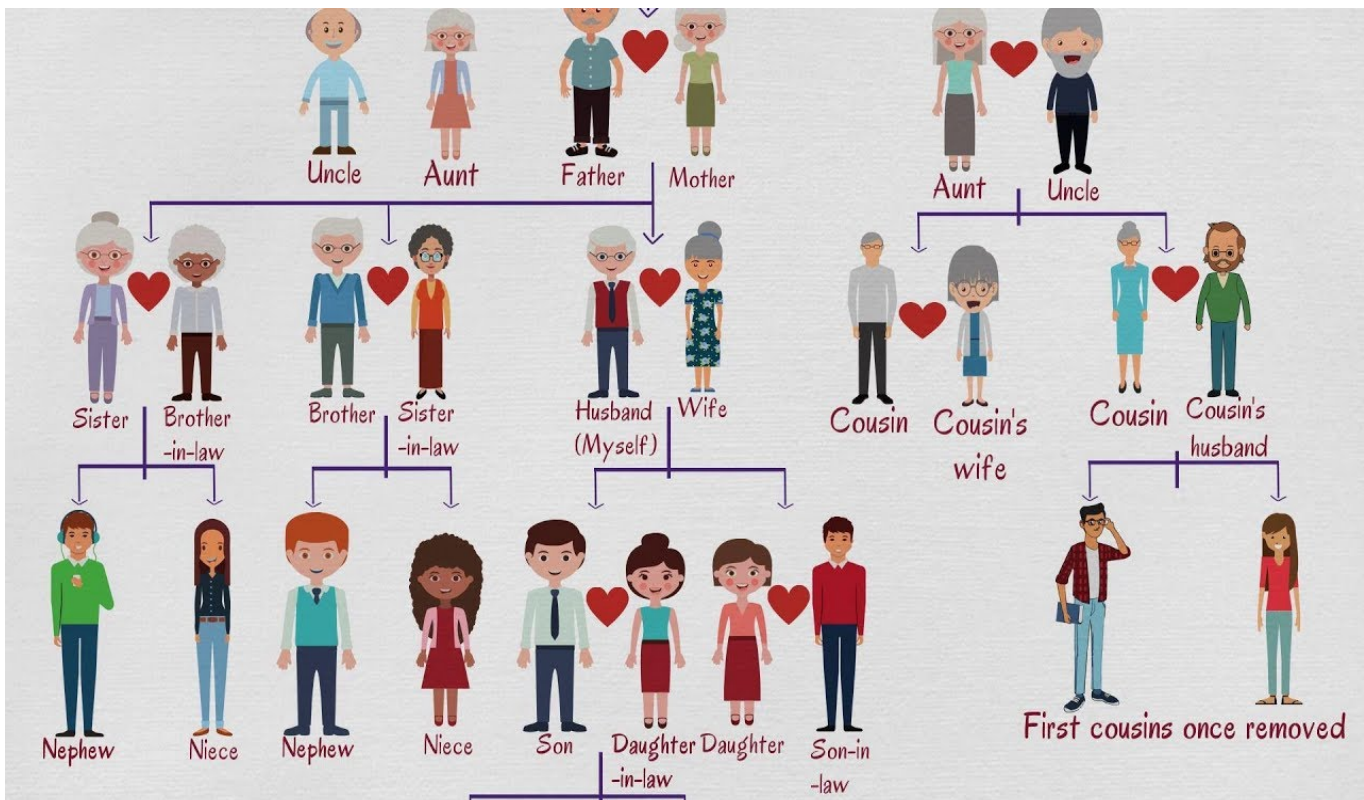

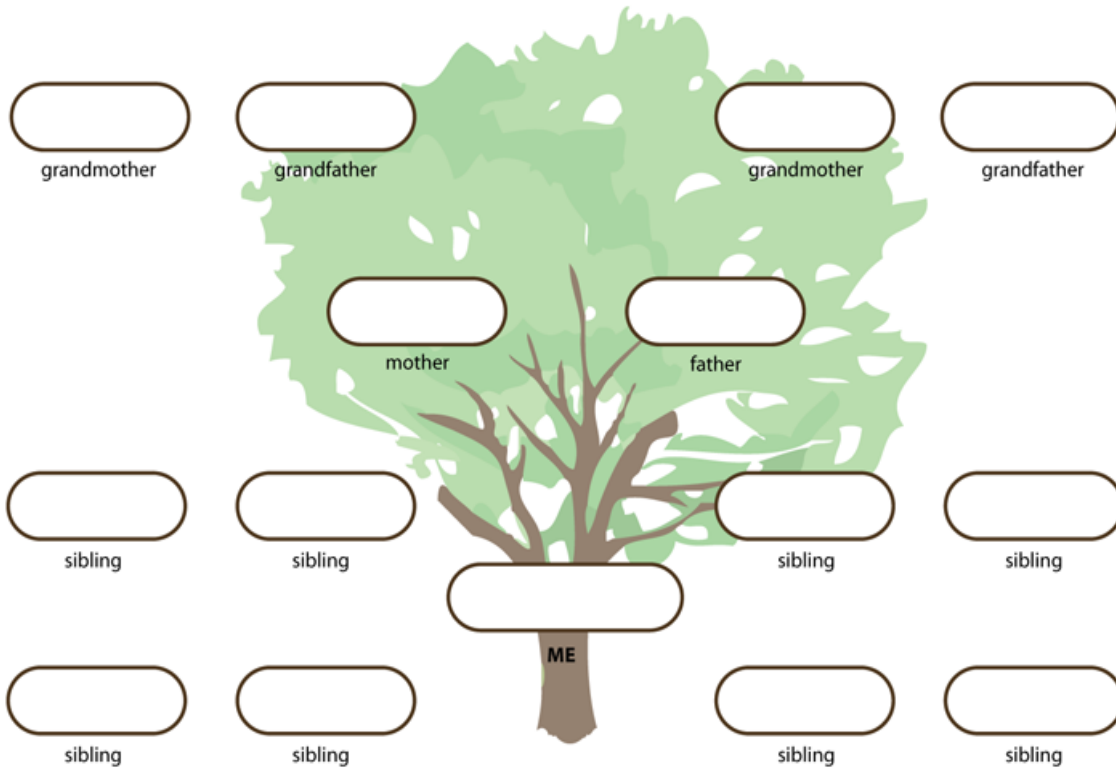

Substantivu singulár no plurál

Singular and plural noun

Iha lian inglés, atu halo substantivu sai plurál tenke tau 's' iha liafuan nia rohan. Ezemplu: house-houses'.

Sekarik liafuan ne'e remata ho y, apaga 'y' ne'e no troka fali ho 'ies'. Ez: family – families'.

Sekarik liafuan ne'e remata ho konsoante, aumenta 'es'. Ez: box- boxes.

Maibé, plurál balu irregulár, hanesan ezemplu: child – childen; man – men.

In English, we build the plural by adding an “s”. For example “house - houses”.

If the word ends in “y”, drop the “y” and replace it with “ies”. For example “family-families”.

If the words end with a consonant add “es”. For example “box-boxes”.

However some plural are irregular like “child-children or man- men”

Expressing possession/Atu espresa posesاون ka pronome

maksoik

Iha lian inglés, ita aumenta ‘s bainhira substantivu mak singulár. Ez: *This is the baby’s plate.*

- Ita aumenta ‘ de’it bainhira substantivu remata ho ‘s’ ona, no iha forma plural. Ez: These are the boys’ clothes.
- Se ko’alia kona-ba buat ka ema na’in-2 ka resin, ita aumenta ‘s ba substantivu ikus hosi fraze ne’e. Ez: This is Ann and John’s son.
- We add “s” when a noun is singular. For example, *This is the baby’s plate.*
- We add ‘ when a noun ends in “s” and is in plural form. For example, These are the boys’ clothes.
- We add ‘s’ to the last noun of a phrase. For example, This is Ann and John’s son.

Interrogative pronoun/Pronome Interrogativu sira

- what = saida. For example : What is your name?
- Where = iha ne’ebé. For example : Where is the cat?
- who = sé. For example : Who is your teacher?
- When = bainhira. For example : When are you going to Canada?
- why = tanbasá/tansá. For example : why is she sick?
- how = oinsá. For example : How do you cook a katupa?
